## Set-up for USER NO ET Mode

# Setting the Active Stations Option

Turn the Function Selector knob to SET UP

Turn the Upper Line to "Set Active Stations"

Turn the **Lower Line** to set the number of valves that are wired into the controller.

Note: The active station count entered in this step will also determine the number of stations that can be accessed within the **Programming**, **Review** and **Copy** function procedures.

## Setting the Master Valve Control

Turn the **Function Selector** knob to **SET UP** Turn the **Lower Line** knob to "Set Master Valve" by default, the Master Valve circuit is **Enabled**. To disable the circuit, turn the **Lower Line** knob to select **Disabled**.

#### **Setting the Start Time**

Turn the Function Selector knob to SCHEDULE

Within the **Schedule** menu, turn the **Upper Line** knob to view "SET IRR START HOUR SCH A Turn the **Lower Line** knob to adjust the hour digit(s) and **a.m./p.m**.

Turn the **Upper Line** knob right one stop to view SET IRR START MIN SCH A Turn the **Lower Line** knob to adjust the minute's digits.

#### **Selecting the Station to Program**

Turn the Function Selector knob to PROGRAM

Turn the **Lower Line** to select station #

## <u>Setting the</u> Program Mode

Turn the Upper Line knob to the right to select "Set Program Mode"

Fully Automated mode is selected by default.Turn the Lower Line knob to the right to select the User - No ET

## Setting the Water Window

<u>Turn the Upper Line knob to the right to select</u> "Use Water Window" <u>Turn the Lower Line knob to the right to select the</u> "No"\_

#### Setting the Cycle Time

Turn the Upper Line knob to the right to select "Set Cycle Time" Turn the Lower Line knob to adjust run time from 0-99 minutes. Turn the Upper Line knob to the right to select "Set Cycle 10ths" Turn the Lower Line knob to adjust run time in Tenths of minutes from .0-.9 minutes. Note: Adjusting the Cycle Time to 00.0 will disable the station.

#### Setting the # of Cycles

T<u>urn the</u> Upper <u>Line knob to</u> the right to <u>select</u> "Set # of Cycles" T<u>urn the Lower Line knob</u> to adjust cycles from 1-20 cycles. Note: This feature is used for grown in of new plant material & to prevent runoff in clay soils or slope areas.

#### Setting the Soak Time

Turn the Upper Line knob to the right to select "Set Soak Time" Turn the Lower Line knob to adjust Soak from 0-480 minutes. Note: This feature is used to delay the watering cycle between run times.

## Setting the Usable Rainfall

Turn the Upper Line knob to the right to select "Usable Rainfall" Turn the Lower Line knob to set to NONE. Note: This feature when Enabled (Yes/100%) is used to prohibit the Controller's Scheduled Watering Times when a \*RAIN PAUSE event has occurred. \* A signal sent by Weathertrak when measurable rain is detected at a Weather Station local to your proximity.

Selecting a Watering Day Schedule

Turn the Upper Line knob to the right to select "Select Water Days"

Turn the Lower Line knob to select the following scheduling methods:

• Everyday - Every day of the year is active

• Set Days - Specific days of the week per month are active.

• Odd/Even - All odd- or even-numbered days are active

• Interval - Active days based on a recurrent interval from 01 (every day) to 31 (every 31st day)

The Everyday scheduling option is selected by default.

## **COPY FUNCTION**

Turn the Function Selector knob to COPYTurn the Upper Line knob to select the source station number.Turn the Lower Line knob to select the destination station number.To select All Stations, turn the Lower Line knob one stop past thehighest station number.Press and hold the COPY button. Release the button whenCOPYING DONE!
