


#### Instructions for use









A 110V GFCI outlet is required. Mark the holes to be drilled for the anchors.




Using A 3/8" drill bit, drill the anchor holes that have been marked.




The plastic anchors provided are for concrete wall applications.



Screw the bracket(s) to the wall at the specified locations. For wood stud walls, bolts should be screwed into the wood backing.




Detach mirror front with four screws.



Lift the mirror up and slide the mirror backing.




Lift the mirror backing up and onto the mounting brackets.




Check the mirror backing is leveled.







The top screw will adjust closer and further, from the mirror and lower screw will adjust up and down.



Mark the hole to be drilled for the screw. Remove mirror backing.




Using a 3/8" drill bit, drill the anchor holes that have been marked.




The plastic anchor provided is for concrete wall applications.




Lift the mirror backing up and onto the mounting brackets.



Screw the bolt to the wall at the specified location. For wood stud walls, bolts should be screwed into wood backing.




Adjust the length of the door stop by screwing it either, clockwise or counterclockwise.




Attach the mirror and connect the wire to the electrical Box.







Push the mirror and attach to the mirror backing.




Attach mirror front to mirror backing with two top supplied screws.




Attach mirror front to mirror backing with two bottom supplied screws.




Using a screwdriver tighten the screws counter-clockwise.




Using a screwdriver tighten the screws clockwise.



Attach the hinged mirror.





Using allen wrench, tighten the top screws clockwise one turn 180 degree.




Using allen wrench tighten the bottom screws counterclockwise one turn 180 degree.











Using allen wrench, tighten the top middle screw clockwise one turn 90 degree or counter-clockwise one turn 90 degree until desired leveling of the hinged mirror has been reached.

Using allen wrench tighten screw counter-clockwise one turn 90 degree or clockwise one turn 90 degree until desired leveling of the hinged mirror has been reached.

Using allen wrench, tighten the top screws clockwise.

Using allen wrench, tighten the bottom screws counter-clockwise.
