BRASS VALVES

Advantages

- **Higher Pressure Rating** — Brass has a higher tensile strength and more elasticity than plastic which make it more resistant to bursting.
- **Higher Chemical Resistance** — Brass is more resistant to chemicals typically found in irrigation water and therefore less susceptible to failure due to cracking.
- **Longer Life** — Brass valves can be used above and below grade whereas plastic degrades over time in extreme environments and in direct sunlight.

Winner

- **Brass** — Brass is the clear winner when confronted with extreme conditions that require a more robust solution. Brass is stronger and more chemical resistant, therefore ideally suited for today's harshest conditions.
